Total Stitch Count: 261w x 180h

Finished size: 13"w x 9" is the approximate finished size. The model is stitched on a 40, Dapple by Picture This Plus. Other suggested fabrics are Dwarf and Alchemy by Picture This Plus.

Floss: You will need 2 skeins each of Gentle Art, Cucumber and Blue Spruce. One skein each, all other colors.

Note: If you choose to stitch the "Merry Christmas", a separate chart is included. Stitch the surrounding Motifs before you stitch Merry Christmas and the leaf border. There is less Snowflakes to the left to accommodate the letters. The leaf border will be a little different from the original Happy Holiday motif.

Instructions:

1. Cross stitch using 1 strand of floss over 2 fabric threads on higher count fabric as 36 or 40 count.

Use 2 strands of floss over 2 fabric threads on lower count fabric as 30, 32, or 14 count.

2. Use 1 strand of Acorn for the Angel's eyebrows and nose and on Santa's face.

3. Use 1 strand of long stitch of Gold Leaf for the reindeers' harness rein.

4. Customize your sampler in the box as shown on the chart using DMC Black or your choice of floss color. Use the Alphabet provided on Page 6.

Framing is by Carolyn DeLong of the Just Cross Stitch store in Limerick, PA. Carolyn also stitched the Snowmen motif finished as an ornament and Merry Christmas, finished as a flatfold/easel display piece. Many thanks, Carolyn and Veronica for your lovely work, as always!
